AHRCers Donate 11 Wheelchairs

Past District Governor Johrita Solari was one of several Rotarians who recently traveled to Nigeria to deliver medical supplies and administer polio drops in support of Rotary International's End Polio Now initiative.

While speaking to AHRCers and sharing photos from her fascinating trip, Johrita also introduced members to Wheels of Hope, an organization which gives the gift of mobility and independence by providing wheelchairs to polio survivors in northern Nigeria. Her inspirational words led individual members and the Club to donate funds towards the purchase of eleven wheelchairs.



Janice Reyes' experience as the mother of a child with Williams Syndrome inspired her to found the ASPIRE Creative Arts Program, which empowers adults with intellectual disabilities through the visual and performing arts. Prior to founding ASPIRE, Janice served for over twenty years as the Executive Director of a day program for adults with intellectual disabilities.

Lori, Janice's daughter, frequently attends ASPIRE, where student ages range from twenty-two to sixty years of age.

Works of art produced by ASPIRE's students are displayed at events across Orange County, including a large showing which is hosted annually by the Main Place Mall in Santa Ana.
